**RESTORATION  
OF MASONRY**



Damp and damaged masonry can be made like new again with KÖSTER Restoration Plaster. First, a horizontal barrier is installed with KÖSTER Crisin 76 Concentrate. Afterwards, the old plaster including all loose particles is removed from the wall and the joints are raked out. Priming the surface with KÖSTER Polysil TG 500 hardens the substrate as well as reduces the mobility of salts. Masonry repairs are carried out with KÖSTER WP Mortar. Before the application of the main plaster coat, KÖSTER Restoration Plaster Key Coarse is applied to ensure an optimal bond to the substrate.

KÖSTER Restoration Plaster allows the masonry to dry without damage. KÖSTER Restoration plaster is hydrophobic and open to vapor diffusion. Salts remaining in the wall are absorbed by the KÖSTER Restoration Plaster preventing salt effloresce and damage to the plaster or paint.

Various KÖSTER Restoration Plasters are available (grey, white, fast and light). KÖSTER Restoration Plaster White is often used in older buildings without subsequent painting. In cases where a smooth decorative surface is required, KÖSTER Fine Plaster can be applied to meet architectural goals. KÖSTER Restoration Plasters can only be painted over with breathable paints (open to vapor diffusion) such as KÖSTER Silicon Paint White or KÖSTER MF 1.
